

Our Services

Home Care Packages

A Home Care Package is an individually funded program offered by the Government to subsidise the cost of a person's care to enable them to remain living independently in their own home. It gives you the choice and flexibility to have services tailored to meet your specific care needs.

Once approved, you will be placed on a government waiting list until a suitable package becomes available.

Once a package is assigned to you, you will receive a letter with a reference number.

TYPES OF PACKAGES

There are four different types of Home Care Packages that have services to meet different needs.

LEVEL 1 is for basic care
LEVEL 2 provides lower-level care
LEVEL 3 provides intermediate care
LEVEL 4 provides high levels of care
